Two complete charts, read as one relationship. Everything that follows is about the space between them — not a ranking of either.

SAMPLE

1 • The eight characters, twice • 八字逐字

Before the dynamics: the raw material. Each person's four pillars, read character by character.

HOW TO READ THIS PAGE • 阅读指引

Each character is read for its own imagery, then placed in the life domain its pillar governs.

年柱 • Year pillar — roots and early years

月柱 • Month pillar — career path and prime years

日柱 • Day pillar — self and the spouse palace

时柱 • Hour pillar — aspirations and later years

Elena

乙亥 — the Vine × early winter Pig: vine-like adaptability, reflective depth • roots and early years

戊寅 — the Mountain × early spring Tiger: mountain-like dependability, bold new beginnings • career path and prime years

壬申 — the Ocean × early autumn Monkey: ocean-like breadth, clever resolve • self and the spouse palace

乙巳 — the Vine × early summer Snake: vine-like adaptability, quick-witted heat • aspirations and later years

Marcus

癸酉 — the Rain × mid-autumn Rooster: rain-like perceptiveness, refined standards • roots and early years

庚申 — the Axe × early autumn Monkey: axe-like decisiveness, clever resolve • career path and prime years

戊辰 — the Mountain × late spring Dragon: mountain-like dependability, transformative ambition • self and the spouse palace

己未 — the Garden × late summer Goat: garden-like nurturing, harvest-time caring • aspirations and later years

Everything that follows — the combinations, the clashes, the elemental exchange — is built from these sixteen characters.

2 • Day master dynamic • 日主关系



Marcus's Earth shapes Elena's Water — this is the cycle's challenging axis, and it is better read as productive friction than as conflict. You will not always want the same thing at the same time, and that difference sharpens both of you. The skill here is translation: asking what the other person is actually optimizing for before deciding you disagree.

The day master is the self at the center of each chart — this is the deepest layer of the pairing, the one that colors everything else.

SAMPLE

3 • What you are to each other • 互为十神

Beyond the day masters, each chart describes the other person through the Ten Gods — the classical vocabulary for roles like supporter, challenger, resource, and outlet. Here is the role each of you plays in the other's chart.

01 **Marcus is Elena's Challenger • 七杀**

Intensity — they push you past your limits and will not let you coast. Growth is guaranteed in this dynamic; gentleness has to be a deliberate practice, not an afterthought.

02 **Elena is Marcus's Venturer • 偏财**

Windfall — excitement, generosity, appetite for the new. The relationship feels alive and full of possibility; steadiness has to be chosen deliberately rather than assumed.

SAMPLE

4 • Stems & branches • 干支合冲

Your charts share 3 stem combinations (乙庚合金、戊癸合火、乙庚合金) — in classical synastry, combining stems are read as deep resonance, two notes forming a chord. 1 branch harmony (巳申) mark points of natural ease — places where you fall into step without negotiating. 1 branch clash (寅申) marks productive friction — points where you want different things at the same moment. Named early, this becomes energy and honesty rather than argument; it only turns sour when it goes unspoken.

Where it lands • 落在何处

Combinations are abstract until you see which pillars they touch — each pillar governs a different part of life.

乙庚合金: Elena's year pillar × Marcus's month pillar — roots and early years meets career path and prime years.

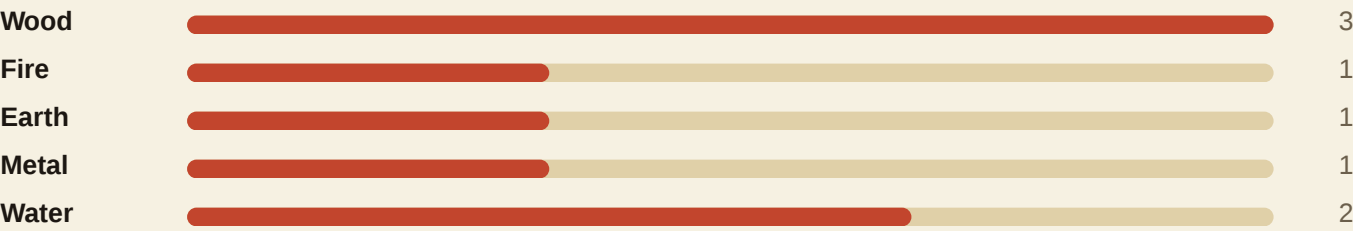
戊癸合火: Elena's month pillar × Marcus's year pillar — career path and prime years meets roots and early years.

乙庚合金: Elena's hour pillar × Marcus's month pillar — aspirations and later years meets career path and prime years.

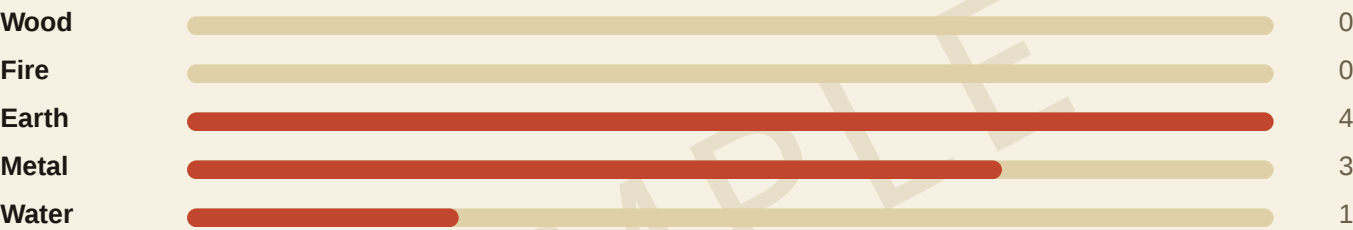
5 • Elemental makeup • 五行互补

Counting the five elements across all stems and branch essences in both charts shows what each of you brings in abundance — and what runs quiet.

Elena



Marcus



Elena's chart leans Wood (strongest thread), with Fire the quietest. Marcus's chart leans Earth, with Wood the quietest. Elena brings Wood in abundance — precisely the element Marcus's chart holds least of. Expect Elena to naturally fill gaps Marcus doesn't notice, and expect Marcus to need explicit invitations to step into Wood territory.

6 • What you give each other • 五行相贈

Beyond the combined picture: the directional flow. Each person's strongest element, read as a gift to the other.

Elena → Marcus • Wood

Elena's strongest thread is Wood — growth and initiative. It is precisely the element Marcus's chart holds least of, so Elena naturally supplies what Marcus doesn't generate alone. Expect Elena to initiate in Wood territory, and Marcus to come alive when invited in rather than pushed.

Marcus → Elena • Earth

Marcus's strongest thread is Earth — steadiness and care. Elena carries Earth more quietly, so Marcus tends to set the tone here. The gift lands best offered, not imposed: Elena receives Earth best through invitation.

7 • Where it shows up • 落在实处

The chart links above are abstract; here is where they land in ordinary days — how you talk, how you move through time together, and how you handle money.

Talk

You are direct with each other — no pretense, no walking on eggshells. That honesty is precious, but delivery matters: the same true sentence can be a gift or a wound depending on timing. Ask "is this a good moment?" before the big one.

Rhythm

Your rhythms dovetail more often than they collide — the chart links lean toward ease. Use the surplus goodwill deliberately: it is the savings account you will draw on in the rare weeks when life gets loud.

Money

At least one of you experiences the other as wealth — something to build for and protect. Money conversations will carry emotional weight beyond the numbers; name what a purchase means (safety? freedom? love?) and the numbers get easier.

8 • The manual • 相处手册

A short owner's manual for each of you — what you need, what you give, and what happens under stress. Written from your day master elements, for the other person to keep.

Elena • 壬水

To Marcus: Venturer • 偏财

Needs

Space and a shoreline. Water needs room to roam and one steady direction to return to — freedom plus a home base. Crowding reads as control.

Gives

Depth and perspective. They see the whole system, stay calm in chaos, and give the relationship its wisdom.

Under stress

When stressed, Water withdraws into depth and goes quiet. Don't demand words on a schedule — offer presence without an agenda and they will surface.

Marcus • 戊土

To Elena: Challenger • 七杀

Needs

Stability and trust. Earth needs to know the ground won't shift — consistency matters more than grand gestures. Surprises, even good ones, need warning.

Gives

Care you can set your watch by. They remember the details, keep the routines, and hold the relationship's center.

Under stress

When stressed, Earth worries in circles and absorbs everyone else's mood. Name the concrete thing that's wrong — vague reassurance doesn't land.

9 • Strengths of this pairing • 组合优势

What this pairing is built for — read these as the relationship's home turf, the ground you can always return to.

01 Coverage

Each of you carries most strongly what the other's chart holds least. You cover each other's blind spots without being asked — one reaches for what the other overlooks.

02 Building instinct

At least one of you experiences the other as wealth — something to build for and protect. This pairing has a natural instinct toward building a shared life, not just sharing one.

03 Chosen fit

Beyond any chart signature, you keep choosing each other — and that choice compounds. The strongest predictor of a good partnership was never the stars; it is the daily decision to turn toward each other.

Watch out

1 branch clash (寅申) means you will want different things at the same moment sometimes. The practice is repair speed — how fast you return to warmth — not avoiding the clash.

10 • Questions worth asking • 值得一问

The report ends; the conversation shouldn't. Six questions chosen for your particular dynamic — ask them over dinner, on a walk, or on a long drive.

01 ***"When we want different things at the same moment, what does a good repair look like for you?"***

Clashes are inevitable; agreed repair rituals are a choice.

02 ***"Where do you want to be pushed, and where do you need me to back off?"***

Intensity is a gift with an on/off switch — label the switch. Asked from Elena's side — in their chart, Marcus shows up as Challenger (七杀).

03 ***"What does a good ordinary Tuesday look like to you?"***

Relationships live in ordinary days; design them on purpose.

04 ***"What are you optimizing for this year — and how can I help?"***

Support lands when it aims at the real target.

05 ***"What should I never tease you about?"***

Every closeness has one tender spot; knowing it is respect.

How this was computed • 排盘方法

Year and month pillars switch at the absolute astronomical moment of each solar term (JieQi) — the mainstream convention used by virtually all charting tools, so this report matches what you would get elsewhere for those pillars.

Day and hour pillars use your birthplace's true solar time (longitude plus the equation of time), which is more precise than the civil-clock approximation most free tools use. Daylight-saving transitions are resolved from the IANA timezone database; impossible or ambiguous birth times are flagged, never silently computed.

If the birth time was unknown, the hour pillar is omitted and the analysis rests on three pillars — still meaningful for day-master and elemental reading, lighter on detail.

How to read this report • 阅读指引

Think of this report as a climate study, not a weather forecast: it maps the tendencies in your chart — how you recharge, where friction tends to arise, what kind of work lets you breathe — not fixed outcomes. It cannot predict specific events, and it is not medical, legal, or financial advice. Its value is in testing: hold these pages against your own experience, keep what rings true, argue with the rest.

No chart here is "better" than the other; there is no such thing as an incompatible pairing, only dynamics worth understanding.
